

## EU-IGAD COVID-19 RESPONSE


## PROGRAMME OVERVIEW


THE EU-IGAD COVID-19 RESPONSE is a €60 million programme funded by the European Union to mitigate the health and socio-economic impact of COVID-19 in the IGAD region.

The programme supports vulnerable groups and frontline workers in 55 cross-border sites across Djibouti, Ethiopia, Kenya, Somalia, Sudan, South Sudan and Uganda.

The programme has four main objectives: (1) to enhance IGAD's capacity to coordinate national responses; (2) to provide health and socioeconomic support for vulnerable groups; (3) to ensure borders and critical supply chains are safe for trade; and (4) to promote digital health solutions.

The programme is managed by UNOPS, coordinated by IGAD, and implemented by IGAD, IOM, TradeMark East Africa (TMEA), UNICEF and UNOPS. The digital health solutions component is managed and implemented by GIZ.


